THE TRUTH ABOUT THE SKULLFORK & BLACK CREEK BLOODLINES BLACK CREEK POLLY OFFSPRING

PART II

Glynn Windham purchased Black Skullfork Shagger and Crotwell's were sold to a vet from Denham Polly, for their offspring. John was most responsible, and Glynn always contended that Polly should receive the most credit. We now know that Polly was one of those chosen few that was a dominant producer, probably due to her intense inbreeding. To my knowledge, she never produced a complete cull, some were better than others, but all of her offspring were better than average individuals. And even more important than that, every one of her offspring that were used for breeding was produced as well. I recall Bruce Roberts stating that you could breed Polly to woods rat and get great rabbit dogs.

When it came time to breed her, Glynn chose not to breed back to Southfork JoJo. In part, he was determined to prove to John L that it wasn't JoJo alone that produced all those great pups, and in time he did just that. Now that's not to say JoJo didn't play a significant role, but, as time would prove, Polly was an outstanding producer regardless of what sire was used.

On 4/15/82, Black Creek Polly gave birth to her sixth litter, sired by Sudon's Drip. Drip was a big chocolate-colored male with heavy Weir Creek breeding, out of

Ronnie bred Piney Woods Creek Sally to Glynn's Smooth On Simon, half-brother/sister mating; both Simon and Sally were off of Black Creek Polly. This cross produced Piney Woods Creek Queen, Piney Woods Creek Princess, Piney Woods Creek Dimond, and Piney Woods Creek Trooper. Queen and Princess were outstanding rabbit dogs, but to my knowledge, they were never bred. Trooper and Diamond

Springs, Louisiana, named Tom Stuckey. These two hounds were amazing to watch and listen to run a rabbit. They both had big ole mouths like the sire and could run a rabbit relentlessly, and they both produced well with limited breedings. Diamond was bred to Lagniappe's Sally, who was off of Sudon's Stemwinder and Moore's Little Red which made her a halfsister to Oak River Decker on her mother's side. Stemwinder was off of Sudon's Seller, a daughter of Mountain Run Jake and Black Creek Polly. There were three that I recall in the Diamond/ Sally litter Lagniappe's Scarlett, Bonnie, and Butler. I have no information on Butler, but Scarlett and Bonnie were great rabbit dogs and producers. Scarlett went on to make her mark in field trials finishing for her AKC field champion title. Diamond was also bred to Cotton Country Tilly. This cross produced a female named Tina Louise XXIII, who was said to be one of the very best rabbit dogs ever in the south.

Let's take a minute to highlight Ronnie Edwards because he played a significant role in the Skullfork/Black Creek hounds and because he is an outstanding individual. There are many more hounds that Ronnie bred along the way, and we'll mention some of those in future articles. He no longer owns beagles, mainly due to the rattlesnake population in his area. He lost countless dogs over the years to rattlesnakes, but his eyes as he talks about the old Ronnie Edwards stories.

John Birr,

John started beagling with his dad, Myron Birr, when he was barely a teen. At that time, they belonged to Lakeshore Beagle Club. He bought his first hound from Bill Russell. Myron and John were part of the membership that chartered the Fox River Beagle Club. He was the Treasurer of Fox River in those formative years and is credited with having found the land and made contact with the owner for what is the current headquarters of the Fox River Beagle Club. John solicited pledges from members to buy the land and went the extra mile in asking for more money to buy fencing. John was on the cutting edge in helping to nudge the gundog movement forward in the late 1980s. He also helped the Northeast Beagle Club join the Midwest Gundog Federation when he was secretary of that club in the mid-eighties. John has always felt that everyone should have the opportunity to run the type of dog that they like. He worked with the Mid-America Brace Federation when it started and was the second president of the MAB. John was the first SPO Secretary at Fox River and worked closely with Ron Milton, then WABC Secretary, to help develop rules for the WABC SPO program. In recent years, he has turned his attention to the Two Couple Pack ("2CP") trials in Wisconsin and now finds himself working on the Gundog Brace License Trial at Fox River. With all this in mind, it's appropriate to look at his breeding

program that helped generate these decisions. It all starts with a female that he bought from Jerry McDowell. This female became the foundation of his breeding program as it is today. "Angel" was bred to Pond Creek Blackie and produced Woodland Farms Lady. He bred Lady to Dueling Grounds Pro-Abe and produced Woodlands Farm Reba. He moved forward to breed Reba to Wolf River Tiny Bull, which produced two Master Hunters -- MH Woodland Farm Carrie and MH Woodland Farm Aretha. Along the way, he also finished Les's Packer as a Master Hunter. John's most memorable times in beagling were when he won the TK Award with Woodland Farms Mandy and the WABC Derby Consistency with Winnebago Land Boogie Flip. Over the years, John has won or consistently placed his hounds in the WABC State Chmpionship trials. John has judged many trials over the years, starting with traditional brace events, SPO sanctioned and licensed trials, the MAB Run-off and gundog brace licensed trials. He judged 2 couple pack trials earlier, but recently has

John has been a visible member of AKC beagle field trials since the early 1960s and has enjoyed his fellowship with a wide variety of people within the beagling fraternity. He has been guided by some of the best beaglers over the years -- people like his dad, Bill "Smokey" Russell, Don Hansen, George Wydeven, Don Bess, Guy Hanagan, and Chuck Holewinski, all current members of the WABC Hall of Fame. John's backyard breeding program finished nine master hunters. He was the breeder of eight of those and co-owned the sire of the ninth. Two of these master hunters were inducted into the Wisconsin Association of Beagle Clubs Hall of Fame. John is the owner of one inductee into the Hall of Fame. He is also the coowner to one nominee for future induction into the Hall of Fame. John was the first Two Couple Pack field trial secretary for Fox River Beagle Club. John promoted Two Couple Pack field trials as fun trials before AKC licensed the trials. John took over as the Clay County and Terre Haute 2CP secretary after the passing of his friend John Guy. In 2008, John was the Two Couple Pack Federation Handler of the Year. John received this award because he handled his friend's dogs due to health issues. I would like to thank my friends at Wisconsin, Central Wisconsin, Milwaukee, Northern Illinois, and Town and Country Beagle Clubs for hosting 2CP trials even though they did not have any club members that competed in the

Jamie dedicated a huge amount of time to the federation promoting the federation and making sure the annual runoff was truly something



RETURN TO PLAY TIME **KENNEL**


